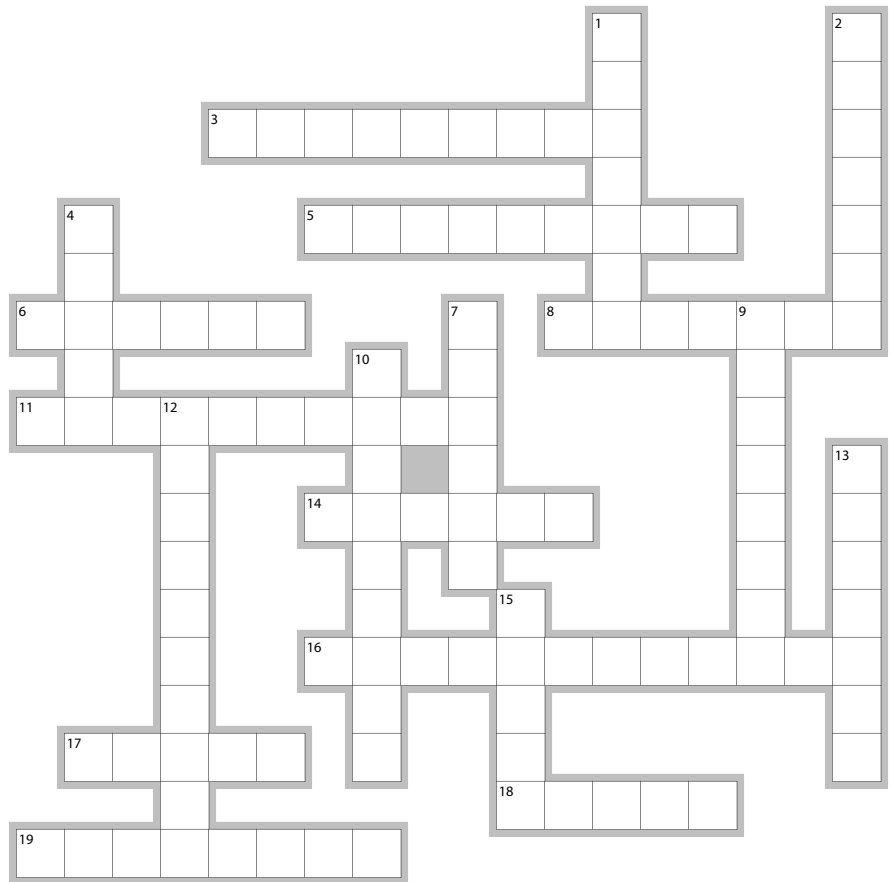

### Across

- 3. A tree with needles or leaves that remain alive and on the tree through the winter and into the next growing season.
- 5. Leaves that are staggered, not located directly across from one other on the twig.
- 6. The edge of a leaf.
- 8. The leafstalk that connects the blade(s) to the twig.
- 11. Deciduous leaf blades that remain on the tree for more than one year.
- 14. The primary rib or central vein of a leaf.
- 16. A leaf with more than one blade. All blades are attached to a single leafstem, and where the leafstem attaches to the twig there is a bud.
- 17. Notches on the outer edge of a leaf.
- 18. Stubby, often sharp, twigs.
- 19. The mark left on the twig where the leaf was previously attached.



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### Down

- 1. A leaf in which the blades, lobes, or veins are arranged like the veins of a feather.
- 2. A leaf in which the blades, lobes, or veins are arranged like fingers on the palm of a hand.
- 4. The flat part of a leaf or leaflet, characteristic of broadleaf trees.
- 7. A leaf margin with smooth, un-toothed edges.
- 9. Two or three leaves that are positioned directly across from one other on the same twig.
- 10. A tree that sheds all of its leaves annually.
- 12. A single leaf blade with a bud at the base of the leaf stem.
- 13. A cone-bearing tree.
- 15. Rounded projections that shape the margins of a leaf.
